The Undersigned, being sworn says, on Information and belief, that _____ did, in the County of Alameda, State of California, on or about October 6, 2011, commit a Misdemeanor, to wit: DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS, a violation of section 23152(a) of the VEHICLE CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) did unlawfully drive a vehicle while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage.

SECOND COUNT

The Undersigned further deposes and says on Information and belief, that said _____ did, in the County of Alameda, State of California, on or about October 6, 2011, commit a Misdemeanor, to wit: DRIVING WHILE HAVING A 0.08% OR HIGHER BLOOD ALCOHOL, a violation of section 23152(b) of the VEHICLE CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) did unlawfully, while having 0.08 percent and more, by weight, of alcohol in the blood, drive a vehicle.

EXCESSIVE BLOOD ALCOHOL/REFUSAL CLAUSE AS TO DEFENDANT _____

It is further alleged that the defendant, during the commission of the above offense, had a concentration of alcohol in his/her blood of .15 percent or more.

FIRST PRIOR CONVICTION AS TO DEFENDANT

The undersigned further alleges that before the commission of the offense specified above, said defendant
1 or about June 24, 2008, was convicted in the Superior Court of the State of
California, in and for the County of ALAMEDA, of the crime of a Misdemeanor, to wit: DRIVING UNDER
